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whether all sidewalks and other facilities primarily intended for the use of pedestrians and bicycles that are to be constructed within the right-of-way of a public street or highway that is a part of the State highway system or an urban highway system must be constructed of permeable pavement. "Permeable pavement" means paving material that absorbs water or allows water to infiltrate through the paving material. Permeable pavement materials include porous concrete, permeable interlocking concrete pavers, concrete grid pavers, porous asphalt, and any other material with similar characteristics. Compacted gravel shall not be considered permeable pavement.

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The Department may exercise the powers and duties set forth in Article 6H <u>(42)</u> of this chapter independently of the Authority and may contract to exercise those powers and duties through a vendor, subject to the provisions of subdivision (39) of this section."

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**SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
