### **Eligibility Requirements and process:**

To obtain services as a homebound customer, the request must be for an identification card. The following criteria must be met:

- Be medically rendered as homebound
- Have supporting medical documentation
- Present proof of age and identity
- Have a DMV image on file

A License & Theft Field Inspector will visit the home of the requestor. The Inspector will have a prepared package for each visit. A predefined application process for the request of the identification card will be completed during the home visit. The process includes verifying the customer's identity, residence and mailing address and obtaining the customer's signature on a service affidavit.

The cost for the identification card is \$10. A customer that is legally blind, 70 years of age or older or is medically cancelled may obtain the identification card at no cost. Based on the customer's age at the time of issuance, the identification card is issued to expire within five or eight years on the customer's date of birth.

The information collected by the License & Theft Inspector will be returned to DMV Headquarters for processing. The identification card will be issued using

the customer's most recent image on file and will be mailed to the address provided by the customer on the service affidavit during the Inspector's home visit.

All documents associated with the issuance of this Special Conditions Transaction are reserved electronically.

**Note:** To obtain a driver license, the customer must be able to submit to the driver license issuance eligibility process.

#### Requirements and instructions:

- The customer must have a DMV image on file
- 2. The request must be for an Identification Card
- The customer must provide proof of age and identity
- 4. The customer must be "Homebound", rendered incapacitated by an illness
- 5. The customer must provide supporting medical documentation
- 6. The "Condition" must be witnessed:
  - a. A home visit from a License & Theft Field Inspector will take place
  - The Inspector will obtain the customer's residence and mailing address on the attached Service Affidavit
  - The Inspector will obtain the customer's signature on the attached Service Affidavit
  - The Inspector will collect the \$10 cost of the Identification Card in the form of a check or money order only
    - If the customer is 70 year of age or older or is medically cancelled, there is no cost for the ID Card
    - ii. Check or money order must be made payable to NCDMV
    - iii. The memo line should reference the customer's NC/ID number
- The information collected by the License & Theft Inspector will be returned to DMV Headquarters for processing and filing
- The Identification Card will be mailed to the address provided by the customer on the Service Affidavit
- All documents associated with the issuance of the Special Conditions transaction will be reserved electronically
