

- By comparison, in 2009 there were 27 total NCTA positions (\$2.1 million budget for salaries)



## NCTA Background Roles & Responsibilities

- Assist with project development during study, design and construction of turnpike projects
- Maintain and operate toll collections systems (this includes toll systems/back office, storefront/call center, payment processing, etc.)
- Fund and manage maintenance and operation of project facilities (this includes everything from potholes fixes, snowplowing, mowing, etc.)
- Compliance and reporting related to bond issuances
- NCTA Board is responsible for setting toll rates for turnpike projects and issuance of bonds




Full route opened to traffic: Jan. 2, 2013

#### Annual Report Overview: Triangle Expressway Revenue in FY 2015






#### Annual Report Overview: Triangle Expressway Transactions in FY 2015




















