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Current Status of Inactive Equipment in Nash County

- Nine cars stored on NCDOT corridor (leased to Carolina Coastal Railway) in Nash County
 - Originally purchased July 2017
 - No room at other NCDOT locations for 765 LF of equipment
 - Have remained at current location at no cost to NCDOT
- First auction held December 2020/January 2021 per SL 2020-91
- Second auction awaited live auction legislation
- Equipment listed with State Surplus for second auction week of March 7, 2022
- Fire incident reported morning of March 10, 2022

Current Status of Inactive Equipment in Nash County

- Cars moved west of original location and are currently divided into two groups
 - 5 cars undamaged by fire and remain in sellable condition
 - 3 cars destroyed/1 car partially destroyed by fire sell for scrap
- All wheel (truck) assemblies are in good condition




Current Status of Inactive Equipment in Nash County

- NCDOT coordinating with Nash County Sheriff's office for regular site visits during period of sale
- Access for sale, scrap and salvage operation

Current Rail Equipment Fleet



- Active equipment fleet insured per agreements
 with Amtrak
 - \$100k deductible per incident
 - Ensures funds for repair of active fleet
 - Will continue to insure active equipment
- Inactive/unrefurbished equipment
 - Low value compared to cost of premium and deductible to insure
 - Repair not required
 - Lack of replacement equipment

Status of Sale of Inactive Equipment

- 5 sellable cars, all currently for sale and taking bids on State Surplus website
- Working with Dept. of Administration on process for live auction per SL 2022-6
- Live auction process will be followed for any equipment remaining unsold from current State Surplus website sale



New Equipment Update

- Active coordination with FRA and Amtrak
- Procurement spec documents complete
- Charlotte facility design advanced
- New equipment includes:
 - Improved ride quality
 - Touchless features
 - Light and bright interiors
 - Cafe service
 - Active displays
 - Wide aisles
 - Modern filtration systems
 - Modern comfortable seats
