General Obligation Sewer Bonds and General Obligation Sewer Bond Anticipation Notes of the Town of Goldston, North Carolina

In accordance with N.C. Gen. Stat. §120-157.2(a) (the "Statute"), the Town of Goldston, North Carolina (the "Town") hereby notifies you of its intent to issue general obligation bonds in the amount of not to exceed \$3,700,000 to finance the costs of the acquisition and construction of sewer infrastructure in order to provide centralized sewer service within the Town, including construction of a pump station, extension of a force main to the City of Sanford and the acquisition and improvement of land and the acquisition of equipment, rights-of-way and easements, if necessary. In addition, the Town anticipates issuing bond anticipation notes in anticipation of the issuance of the bonds at the completion of construction.

The obligation of the Town to make payments of principal and interest on these bonds and the bond anticipation notes shall constitute a pledge of the faith and credit of the Town within the meaning of the Constitution. The voters of the Town approved the issuance of these bonds and the bond anticipation notes at a general obligation bond referendum held on June 22, 2010.

The Town expects that the North Carolina Local Government Commission (the "Commission") will consider for approval the Town's issuance of the bonds and the bond anticipation notes at the Commission's meeting scheduled for July 10, 2012.
