Dear Members:

On April 27, 2012, Cape Fear Public Utility Authority (Authority), was notified that the application for a Clean Water State Revolving Fund loans on the 30th Street Sewer System Rehabilitation of \$1,750,000 and the McCumber's Ditch Sewer Rehabilitation of \$1,250,000 were determined to be eligible and the loans for these projects are pending approval by the Local Government Commission.

To date, the following milestones have been met as required by the NC Department of Environment and Natural Resources:

o March 13, 2012, the Engineering Reports on both projects were approved.

We hereby are notifying you of the Authority's intent to proceed with the 30th Street Sewer System Rehabilitation and McCumber's Ditch Sewer Rehabilitation projects and subsequent loan approval by the Local Government Commission. The next phase for these projects under the Clean Water SRF Program is the Plans and Specifications Phase with a deadline of December 3, 2012.

RE: Financing of the Madison-Mayodan Public Library Capital Project by Rockingham County, North Carolina

Ladies and Gentlemen:

In accordance with Section 120-157.2(a) of the General Statutes of North Carolina, as amended, Rockingham County, North Carolina (the "County") hereby notifies you of its intent to utilize an installment purchase contract under North Carolina General Statute 160A, Article 3, Section 20. The principal amount is not to exceed \$1,250,000 and will be used to partially fund the construction of a new public library building in the Madison and Mayodan area of the County. The Towns of Madison and Mayodan have each committed to contribute an amount not to exceed \$312,500 (total of \$625,000) to the project and intend to remit to the County their portion on an annual basis over the term of this proposed financing agreement. The remainder of the project cost, approximately \$900,000, is being met through grants that have been secured by the County and private donations that have been made to the Western Friends of the Library organization. Construction bids for this project were opened on April 26, 2012. The County anticipates that the North Carolina Local Government Commission will consider approval of the issuance of this proposed debt at its meeting scheduled for June 5, 2012.
