General Statute 120-157.1 to 157.9 Report on Proposed Debt Issuance

#### Fiscal Research Division:

The City of Henderson has applied for State Revolving Loan Funds through the NC Department of Environment and Natural Resources Infrastructure Finance Section for the purpose of replacement and updating major components of the Henderson Water Reclamation Facility. It is anticipated that debt service in the approximate amount of \$16,615,000 will be issued for this project with one million in the form of principal forgiveness, which will reduce the debt amount. The anticipated debt repayment term is 20 years. The debt will be repaid through sewer revenues of the City of Henderson. These improvements will increase operational efficiencies at the plant as well as the reliability of the treatment facility.

The City has also applied for State Revolving Loan Funds for improvements to the Sandy Creek Pump Station. These improvements will provide a more reliable pumping system in replacement of equipment and components that have exceeded their useful life resulting in lower pumping capacity and potentially sewer overflow. The estimated cost of the project is \$1.8 million, with half of that amount in the form of principal forgiveness. The debt repayment and funds to repay the debt are the same as the above project.

This letter is intended to satisfy Session Law 2011-291. The City of Lumberton is moving forward with the construction of above listed project with an approximate cost of \$1,881,759. The project is being funded by CWSRF and will be submitted for Local Government Commission approval. The Project consists of the following major items:

1. Installation of approximately 1,500 linear feet of 18-inch sanitary sewer to replace existing sanitary sewer.

2. Trenchless rehabilitation of approximately 21,500 linear feet of 6, 8, 10, 12, 18 and 24-inch sanitary sewer.

3. Replacement of 25 sanitary sewer manholes.

4. Rehabilitation of approximately 80 sanitary sewer manholes.

5. Replacement of approximately 300 sanitary sewer service connections from new and/or rehabilitated main to the public right-of-way

Notice to the Joint Legislative Committee on Local Government Proposed Financing of Wastewater Treatment Plant Rehabilitation

As Finance Officer for South Granville Water and Sewer Authority, I am providing this notice in accordance with N.C. Gen. Stat. Section 120-157.2 of a proposed local government capital project that requires approval of the North Carolina Local Government Commission (LGC) and requires debt to be issued in an amount exceeding \$1,000,000.

Purpose: Rehabilitate wastewater treatment facilities in Butner NC to comply with Phase I of nutrient and discharge limits, commonly referred to as the "Falls Lake Regulations", enacted by the NC Legislature.

Scope: Major construction activity

Debt Requirements/Financing/Repayment: NCDENR intends to finance the entire construction (approximately \$29.1 million) under the State Revolving Fund program; however final cost projections and funding notification are pending. The attached letter from NCDENR dated 04/01/11 limited the funding to \$22 million; however subsequent changes in funding limits allowed the intended funding to increase to \$29.1 million, as shown in the attached supporting documents. Financing would be a loan with a 20 year repayment term. Any additional project costs will be paid from existing capital improvement funds designated as part of existing fund balance. Future debt service payments will be paid from revenue derived from customer rates and services.
