Re: Financing of Downtown Multi-Use Sports and Entertainment Facility by the City of High Point, North Carolina

Ladies and Gentlemen:

In accordance with Section 120-157.2(a) of the General Statutes of North Carolina, as amended, the City of High Point, North Carolina (the "City") hereby notifies you of its intent to issue limited obligation bonds (the "Bonds") pursuant to Section 160A-20 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, as amended, to finance the cost of acquiring, constructing and equipping a downtown multipurpose sports and entertainment facility and related appurtenances (the "Project"). The City anticipates that the Bonds will be issued in a principal amount of approximately \$35,000,000. The City's obligations with respect to the Bonds will be secured by a deed of trust granting a lien on all or a portion of the site of the Project, together with all improvements and fixtures located or to be located thereon, subject to permitted encumbrances.

The Bonds are expected to be sold pursuant to a negotiated public offering on or about October 25, 2017, at which time the interest rates on the Bonds shall be determined.

The City anticipates that the North Carolina Local Government Commission will consider approval of the sale and issuance of the Bonds at its meeting scheduled for October 3, 2017.
