To Whom It May Concern:

This letter is to serve as Notice in compliance with NCGS 120-157.1 through 157.4 that the City of Thomasville intends to apply for a loan in an amount of \$8,334,351 through NCDENR/DWI/CWSRF to cover capital costs for the purpose of constructing a sewer line rehabilitation project known as the **North Hamby Creek Outfall Sanitary Sewer Phase II** project consisting of approximately 9,965 linear-feet of 24-inch diameter pipe and associated manholes and appurtenances. The purpose of the project is to increase the line size to handle existing flows and help prevent Sanitary Sewer Overflows into the Yadkin/Pee-Dee Basin. Loan repayments will be made from revenues of the Water/Sewer Enterprise Fund. This loan, if approved by NCDENR/DWI/SRF, will go before the LGC for approval as well.

This letter is to serve as Notice in compliance with NCGS 120-157.1 through 157.4 that the City of Thomasville intends to apply for a loan in an amount of \$1,150,000 through NCDENR/DWI/SWWR and CWSRF to cover capital costs for the purpose of constructing a sewer line rehabilitation project known as the **Hanks Branch Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation Phase I** project consisting of replacement of approximately 3,005 linear-feet of 8-inch thru 12-inch diameter pipe, CIPP lining of approximately 5,540 linear-feet of 8-inch thru 12-inch diameter pipe, restoration of approximately 45 manholes and associated work. The purpose of the project is to rehabilitate the line to help prevent Sanitary Sewer Overflows into the Yadkin/Pee-Dee Basin by stopping exfiltration, inflow and infiltration. Loan repayments will be made from revenues of the Water/Sewer Enterprise Fund. This loan, if approved by NCDENR/DWI/SWWR and CWSRF, will go before the LGC for approval as well.


