County of Union, North Carolina Enterprise Systems Revenue Bonds, Series 2017

In accordance with N.C. Gen. Stat. §120-157.2(a) (the "Statute"), the County of Union, North Carolina (the "County") hereby notifies you of its intent to issue its Enterprise Systems Revenue Bonds, Series 2017 (the "Bonds") pursuant to Article 5 of Section 159 of the North Carolina General Statutes in an aggregate principal amount of approximately \$66,000,000, the proceeds of which will be used (1) to finance the costs of extensions, additions and capital improvements to, or the renewal and replacement of capital assets of, or purchasing and installing new equipment for, the County's water and sewer systems (the "Projects"), (2) to pay a portion of the interest on the Bonds during construction of the Projects and (3) to pay the costs of issuing the Bonds.

The Projects to be financed with the proceeds of the Bonds will include, among other things, (1) Crooked Creek Headwork Improvements consisting of 10.5 MGD influent pumping and screening, 3 MG equalization basin, 1,200ft of 15-in replacement gravity sewer, 1,500ft of 16-in replacement force main, and related improvements, (2) Catawba River Water Treatment Plant Expansion (Intake & Reservoir) providing for environmental mitigation for new 1 billion gallon (BG) raw water reservoir at Catawba Raw Water Treatment Plant, subsequent design and construction of 1 BG raw water reservoir, and a new raw water intake and pump station along the Catawba River and (3) Twelve Mile Waste Water Treatment Plant Project providing for 1.5 million gallons per day (MGD) capacity expansion from 6 MGD to 7.5 MGD (Phase 1) and related improvements.

The Bonds will be special obligations of the County secured by and payable from the net revenues of the County's water and sewer system on parity with all other bonds issued under the General Trust Indenture for the Bonds. The County expects that the Bonds will have a term not to exceed 30 years and a true interest cost not exceeding 5.00%.

The County expects that the Local Government Commission of North Carolina (the "Commission") will consider for approval the County's proposal to issue the Bonds at the Commission's meeting scheduled for August 1, 2017 or at such other meeting as the County and the Commission may determine.
