\$5,290,000 City of Winston-Salem, North Carolina General Obligation Bonds, Series 2017A

In accordance with N.C. Gen. Stat. §120-157.2(a), the City of Winston-Salem, North Carolina (the "City") hereby notifies you of its intent to issue the above-referenced bonds (the "Bonds") in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$5,290,000 to finance the capital costs of (1) to upgrade and renovate general government and public safety facilities and acquire land for future fire station, (2) to construct, renovate and improve certain parks and recreational facilities, including, among other things, picnic shelters, playgrounds and swimming pools and including building, lighting, golf course and trail improvements located at parks and recreational facilities, and (3) resurfacing certain streets and repairing and replacing certain bridges.

The Bonds will be general obligations of the City. They will be secured by the full faith and credit of the City, and the City will annually levy and collect an *ad valorem* tax sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the Bonds. The City expects that the term of the Bonds will be approximately 20 years.

The City expects that the North Carolina Local Government Commission (the "Commission") will consider for approval the City's proposal to issue the Bonds at the Commission's meeting scheduled for June 6, 2017.
