## County of Caldwell, North Carolina Installment Contract

In accordance with N.C. Gen. Stat. §120-157.2(a), the County of Caldwell, North Carolina (the "County") hereby notifies you of the County's intent to enter into an installment contract under Section 160A-20 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, as amended (the "Contract"), the proceeds of which will be used to pay the capital costs of constructing, equipping and furnishing two new Emergency Medical Services bases in the County located at 214 Clark Street, Lenoir, North Carolina and 201 Taylorsville Road NE, Lenoir, North Carolina (the "Projects").

To secure the County's obligations under the Contract, the County will execute and deliver a deed of trust and security agreement (the "Deed of Trust") under which the County will grant a lien on and create a security interest in all or such portion of the County's fee simple interest in the sites where the Projects will be located, together with all improvements and fixtures located thereon.

The County expects that the Contract will have a term of between 15 and 20 years and that the amount advanced to the County under the Contract will not exceed \$2,500,000. The County may pay its obligations under the Contract from any source of funds available to it in each year. The County's obligation to make payments under the Contract is a limited obligation of the County, subject to annual appropriation, and will not constitute a direct or indirect pledge of the faith and credit or the taxing power of the County.

The County will request that the Local Government Commission of North Carolina (the "Commission") consider for approval the County's proposal to execute and deliver the Contract at the Commission's meeting scheduled for September 11, 2018 or at such other meeting as the County and the Commission may determine.
