RE: The Charlotte-Mecklenburg Hospital Authority d/b/a Atrium Health Series 2018 Revenue and Refunding Revenue Bonds

Ladies and Gentlemen:

In accordance with Section 120-157.2(a) of the General Statutes of North Carolina, as amended, The Charlotte-Mecklenburg Hospital Authority d/b/a Atrium Health ("Atrium Health") hereby notifies you of its intent to issue Health Care Revenue and Refunding Revenue Bonds under North Carolina General Statute 131E-26(a) governing hospital authority borrowings. The Bonds will be issued to primarily refund outstanding Series 2009A bonds in the amount of \$164.2 million but the Bonds are also expected to include \$400 million of new money debt that will be used to: (i) reimburse Atrium Health for up to \$300 million of capital expenditures incurred over the past eighteen (18) months in connection with its August 2, 2016 Declaration of Official Intent to Reimburse Expenditures with Proceeds of Debt Pursuant to U.S. Department of Treasury Regulations; and (ii) fund a minimum of \$100 million of capital expenditures from Atrium Health's projected capital outlays of approximately \$1 billion in 2019-2020. Item (i) reimbursement capital is currently expected to include renovations to Carolinas

HealthCare System NorthEast, Emergency Department renovations at Carolinas HealthCare System Stanly, lab renovations at Carolinas Medical Center and the acquisition and installation of health care, IT and other equipment and other routine capital expenditures. Item (ii) capital is currently expected to include multiple facility renovations and aesthetic upgrades and the installation of health care, IT and other equipment and other routine capital expenditures.

Atrium Health anticipates that the North Carolina Local Government Commission will consider approval of the issuance of this proposed debt at its meeting scheduled for October 2, 2018.
