Dear Chairs of the North Carolina Joint Legislative Committee on Local Government:

The purpose of this letter is to notify you, pursuant to N.C. General Statute §120-157.2(a), that the Ingrams Township Water District in the County of Johnston, North Carolina (the "District") intends to finance a hydraulic improvements project through a Clean Water State Revolving Fund reserve loan. The Ingrams Township Water District 2018-19 Hydraulic Improvements Project (the "Project") includes construction/installation of a parallel 16-inch water main along a 13,700 linear feet section of US 301 and modest improvements at the connection to the Town of Smithfield system. The Project will allow the existing line on U.S. 301 to be used to supply the West System in Johnston County, enabling the Town of Four Oaks to return to chloraminated water and the South Johnston Tank to "float" as it was designed to do aiding in the supply to the rapidly growth West System. The project will create a new supply line to the Ingrams Township Water District and the rest of the East System in Johnston County. The total estimated cost of the Project is \$2,950,000. The State Water Infrastructure Authority has approved the project as eligible to receive a Clean Water State Revolving Fund reserve loan of \$2,950,000.

The District plans to seek Local Government Commission ("LGC") approval of the \$2,950,000 Clean Water State Revolving Fund reserve loan at an LGC meeting occurring on or after August 7, 2018.
