Notice to the Joint Legislative Committee on Local Government Concerning Proposed Financing by Richmond County

To the Committee:

As counsel to Richmond County, North Carolina, and as required under N.C. Gen. Stat. Section 120-157.2, I am providing this notice of a proposed local government capital project that requires approval of the North Carolina Local Government Commission and requires debt to be issued in an amount exceeding \$1,000,000. Here is information about the proposed financing –

Project description -- Improvements to the County's public water system, especially including the extension of water lines to rural areas in the southeastern part of the County

LGC meeting for consideration - August or September 2018

Amount to be financed – estimated as up to approximately \$2,184,000

Type of financing – USDA revenue bonds, along with revenue bond anticipation notes

Description of other sources of financing – The County expects that the amount borrowed, together with a County contribution of approximately \$55,000, will pay substantially all the costs of the project.

Estimated financing term - The County expects a financing term of

approximately 40 years, which is not longer than the expected useful life of the property being financed.

Estimated interest rate – USDA has committed to a permanent financing annual rate of 2.75%. The County expects the rate on the construction financing to be lower.

Expected source of repayment – water and sewer enterprise revenues
