Re: Financing of Community College Facilities by County of Wake, North Carolina

Ladies and Gentlemen:

In accordance with Section 120-157.2(a) of the General Statutes of North Carolina, as amended, the County of Wake, North Carolina (the "County") hereby notifies you of its intent enter into an installment financing agreement with a financial institution to be determined pursuant to Section 160A-20 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, as amended, to finance, among other things, the cost of community college facilities. At present, the County anticipates that the amount to be financed for community college facilities will be approximately \$75,000,000. The County's obligations to pay the installment payments under the installment financing agreement will be secured by a Deed of Trust to certain public school facilities being financed under the same installment financing agreement.

The County anticipates that the North Carolina Local Government Commission will consider approval of the issuance and sale of the Bonds at its meeting scheduled for August 7, 2018.
