

Drinking Water State Revolving Fund  
Neilson Water Treatment Plant Modernization Re-Amended \$100,000,000 million***

In accordance with N.C. Gen. Stat. §120-157.2(a) (the "Statute"), the City of Winston-Salem, North Carolina (the "City") hereby notifies you of its intent to enter into debt via loan assistance through the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund program for the modernization of the Neilson Water Treatment Plant in a re-amended amount not to exceed \$100,000,000. The City intends to apply the proceeds of the loan towards the rehabilitation cost for the Nielson Water Treatment Plant. This project is included in the City of Winston Salem's Capital Improvement Plan and annual operating budget for all required years starting with FY 2021-2022.

The City expects that the North Carolina Local Government Commission (the "Commission") will consider for approval the City's proposal to issue the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund loan at the Commission's meeting scheduled for October 5, 2021.
