Re: Bond Financing of Public Safety Improvements by Town of Morrisville, North Carolina

Ladies and Gentlemen:

In accordance with Section 120-157.2(a) of the General Statutes of North Carolina, as amended, the Town of Morrisville, North Carolina (the "Town") hereby notifies you of its intent to issue general obligation bonds (the "Bonds") pursuant to The Local Government Bond Act, Article 4 of Chapter 159 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, as amended, in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$1,110,000 for the purpose of providing funds, together with any other available funds, to finance various public safety improvements, including, without limitation, (a) new public safety radio equipment and (b) a new fire station.

The issuance of the Bonds would be subject to the authorization set forth in Article V, Section 4(2) of the North Carolina Constitution and Section 159-49 of the General Statutes of North Carolina which permits the issuance of general obligation bonds without a vote of the people to the extent of two-thirds of the amount by which the Town's outstanding indebtedness was reduced during the last preceding fiscal year. The Bonds would be secured by the full faith and credit and taxing power of the Town, without limitation as to rate or amount, and the Town would expect to pay the debt service on the Bonds from general fund revenues of the Town.

It is expected that the proposed bonds will have a term of approximately 20 years. Such bonds are expected to be sold by the Local Government Commission by competitive

sale pursuant to a public offering on or about April 26, 2022, and the interest rate on such bonds will be the lowest interest rate bid for the bonds at the time such bonds are sold.

The Local Government Commission is expected to approve the issuance of the Bonds at its April 5, 2022 meeting. Please do not hesitate to contact me if you need any additional information relating to the Bonds or the proposed projects to be financed.
