 - Largest single SIS in the world 1.3 Million Students
 - 113 LEAs, 99 Charters, ~2500 Schools
 - ~150K Named Users, ~50K Unique Users / day, >20K Concurrent Users
 - >35M Web Transactions Per Day, Peak of >150K Reports Per Day
 - Consistent Backlog of >100 Data Extract / Report Requests
 - Authoritative Source: Many data elements for federal & state reporting

- Staff Supporting NC WISE
 - High Water Mark of 121 During Wave 3 Deployment
 - Project and Operations
 - W3 Contractors (29 FT, 30 PT), CEDARS, RIF(s), ITS
 - Currently approximately
 - 27 FTEs 'Day-to-Day Support' of the program
 - 15 FTEs doing 'Project' work Varies by Project Mix
 - ~ 4 FTEs Within TS Support NC WISE 'as needed'
 - ~46 FTEs Support NC WISE Projects and Operations
 - Net Reduction of Staff to support LEAs
 - NCDPI was impacted by a 21% reduction last year
 - Technology Services just lost 11 more July 1



- Major Projects Recent
 - Hardware Upgrade July '10
 - LEAs are experiencing better system performance
 - Last supporting environments completing now
 - Resolved ITS Security Policy Issue
 - Running out of WDC
 - YET July '10
 - Very successful: Coupled with HW Upgrade
 - SAS Flexible Reporting March '10
 - Pilot/Phase 1 26 LEAs with 14 others being trained

 - CMS/WCPSS Integration
 - Both LEAs actively engaged
 - CMS/WCPSS/NCDPI Executive Council
 - Resolution of Business Process Issues
 - Currently Identifying/Documenting Differences
 - Adopt CMS and/or WCPSS differences where possible
 - Minimize business impact to NCDPI, CMS and WCPSS
 - All entities to benefit
 - Reporting
 - Cost avoidance at NCDPI
 - UID Administration (CEDARS)
 - Student transfers
 - Implementation Date: July 2011

 - On target for YE10
 - Yearly upgrade going forward
 - SAS Flexible Reporting Statewide Rollout
 - All LEAs/Charters will have access
 - On target for 1Q11
 - CEDARS Support
 - Large NC WISE & TS Impact
 - NC WISE & CEDARS are complimentary Systems
 - NC WISE is the day-to-day tool of the LEAs/schools
 - CEDARS is the Longitudinal Data System for researchers, etc.

- Parent Assistant Current
 - Deployed In:
 - CMS
 - WSFCS Pilot
 - Guilford County Schools Special Implementation
 - Benefits
 - Dropout Reduction
 - Data Integrity
 - Demographic Data Cleanup
 - Free & Reduced Lunch
 - E-Rate Funding
 - Cost Avoidance
 - Progress Reports
 - Individual LEA initiatives to involve parents
 - Technical question answered allowing less expensive deployment

- Parent Assistant Future
 - Single most asked for functionality
 - NC WISE has materials for deployment
 - Once PA is in place:
 - LEAs are responsible for implementation
 - NC WISE has little role
 - Policy is at the LEA and school level
 - Costs of Deployment
 - ~\$400K Implementation
 - ~\$250K Annual
 - Governor's Expansion Budget Request
 - Could deploy mid-February '11 if funded



- Issues/Risks
 - Security Deviation
 - ITS Policy Changes \$\$
 - Continuity Of Operations
 - Support of new NCDPI LEA
 - DJJ&DP
 - DHHS
 - RttT Impact (?)
 - Ability to be nimble in serving LEAs' needs
 - NCDPI has taken a 21% reduction + 11 TS
 - RttT
 - Different Rules Apply:
 - Higher Ed
 - LEAs

- Opportunities
 - As NC WISE and TS within NCDPI are able to provide timely and quality service to the LEAs, we lower the need for LEAs to 'go their own way' for:
 - Data Warehouse Products
 - Parent Assistant-like Products
 - Career Planning Tools
 - Professional Development, etc.

Thereby saving funds for the state.

 - Funding for Parent Assistant for LEAs
 - UERS Re-write
 - Headcount Stability
