Advanced Authentication (Two-Factor)

Current Status

- DOJ has a near-term requirement for Advanced Authentication (AA) by Sept 2014
 - Driven by Federal Requirements
 - Associated with the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) and specifically the Criminal Justice Information System (CJIS) Security Policy
- ITS and DOJ collaborated to define requirements
- Distributed an RFP to solve immediate requirements with flexibility to adapt in the future
- RFP responses are under evaluation
- Award expected by April 2014
- Plan to implement DOJ functionality requirements by September 2014, pending successful RFP award and DOJ funding
