BROUGHTON HOSPITAL

- Approved to return by CMS to Medicaid program as of June 20th
- Appeal to Joint Commission on the Accreditation of Healthcare Organizations
 - April 2007- 9 conditions of participation
 - December- 29 conditions of participation
 - August 2008- 18 conditions of participation

BROUGHTON HOSPITAL

- New Director- Thomas Mahle start date August 25
- 18 years of broad experience in health care management and service delivery

BROUGHTON HOSPITAL

- He has served at all levels in psychiatric service delivery including two years early in his career as a mental health technician in a psychiatric hospital providing general adult and chemical dependency services.

BROUGHTON HOSPITAL

- Seven years as Director of Behavioral Medicine at Mount Sinai Medical Center/Miami Heart Institute in Miami Beach, FL. His experience at Mount Sinai included serving as administrator of its 99-bed inpatient psychiatric unit, administrative director for the Alzheimer/Memory Clinic, and administrator for the Department of Psychiatry/Psychology.

BROUGHTON HOSPITAL

- Thomas Mahle earned a Bachelor of Arts degree in Psychology from Kings College in Wilkes-Barre, PA, and a Master of Science in Healthcare Administration from Old Dominion University in Norfolk, VA.

CHERRY HOSPITAL

- Serious incident- Results in finding of immediate jeopardy by DHSR
- Plan of correction submitted to CMS 8/22

CHERRY HOSPITAL

- Immediate Actions
 - Closure of 23 bed unit where incident occurred
 - Involved staff reassigned to non-clinical positions
 - Re-training of staff
 - Improve communications with Division/Advocacy/Hospitals
- Recent Incident

CENTRAL REGIONAL HOSPITAL

- Building of new facility- lessons learned from Central Regional Hospital

CENTRAL REGIONAL HOSPITAL

- Move of John Umstead staff and patients- June 21
- Current staff – 1100 w/DDH 1860
- Current Census – 231 w/DDH 450
- Disability Rights review and comments

CENTRAL REGIONAL HOSPITAL
