CAPAG Activity Update

- Last CAPAG meeting held at NCSU – October 12
 - Follow up call – November 13
- Numerous Technical Work Group calls since
- Objectives
 - To complete the “Definition” of the priority mitigation options prior to cost and benefit analysis
 - Begin to consider recommendations
- Adaptation
 - Interest of LCGCC at October 3 meeting
 - Interest of TWG and CAPAG as an early recommendation
- Considerations for Adaptation
 - Task force or study commission
 - Identify sectors for inclusion in plan
 - Coordination with Public Safety, Emergency Management, Public Health, Agriculture, etc. necessary
 - Develop State plan

CAPAG Schedule / Next Steps

- **Analysis underway for selected mitigation options**
 - Costs
 - Benefits, including jobs created
- **Next CAPAG meeting – Jan 24, '07**
 - Initial reports on analyses
 - Final development of and approval on initial recommendations
- **Consideration of extending CAPAG schedule to coordinate with and support LCGCC work**
