**COMMISSION MEETING:**

You are reminded that the Legislative Commission on Global Climate Change (LCGCC) meeting this month will be held in conjunction with the Emerging Issues Forum (Forum). The Forum is being held from 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. on Monday 11 February 2008 and from 8:00 a.m. until 2:30 p.m. on Tuesday 12 February 2008. The Forum is being held at the Jane S. McKimmon Center, which is located at the intersection of Western Boulevard and Gorman Street on the campus of North Carolina State University in Raleigh. Members of the LCGCC who have registered for the Forum are encouraged to attend as many of the Forum events as possible. Members of the LCGCC who have pre-registered are also invited to attend the Leadership Dinner at 6:00 p.m. on Monday 11 February 2008. A copy of the Forum agenda is attached for your information.

**You are also reminded that the LCGCC will meet at 2:30 p.m. Monday 11 February 2008 in Room 3 of the McKimmon Center.** This is a regular business meeting of the LCGCC and is open to the public. Please note, however, that seating capacity for observers is limited to a maximum of 110 persons for reasons of safety. **No more than this number of attendees will be admitted.** Admission will be on a first-come, first-serve basis. You are reminded that all Forum events other than the LCGCC meeting require registration and payment of a registration fee. Unfortunately, registration for the Forum is closed and the waiting list in case of cancellation is very long. Because of the space limitations noted above, persons who have not be able to register for the Forum **should not** consider the meeting of the LCGCC as an alternative to registration for the Forum.
