3. Global warming adaptation strategies to conserve fish and wildlife habitats and maintain healthy and genetically diverse wildlife populations.
4. Global warming adaptation to sea-level rise in the coastal plain of North Carolina.
5. Estuarine shoreline erosion and coastal hazards in the changing climate of North Carolina.
