Active Shooter Drills

- 115C-47(40)
 - Requires each Local Board of Education to have a School Risk Management Plan
- <u>115C-105.49(a)</u>
 - Requires annual drill in each school
- 2014 Critical Incident Response Training
 - All 115 LEAs received training
 - Training provided again in 2016

School Resource Officers (SROs)

- <u>2013: Session Law 2013-360, Section 8.36</u>
 - -\$7 Million Recurring
 - -\$1 to \$2 Local / State Match
 - -62 LEAs
 - ■11 Charter Schools
 - ■210 SRO Positions

Panic Alarms

- Fiscal Year 2013-2014: Session Law 2013-360
 - -\$1 to \$1 Local / State Match
 - **\$1,366,579** Appropriated
 - -2181 Regular Schools
 - 17 Charter Schools
 - LEAs who did not receive grants, installed alarms at local cost

SPK UP NC

- Anonymous Reporting Application for Students
 - 50 pilot schools in Avery, Macon, Winston-Salem Forsyth, and Wayne Counties
 - Expand to all middle and high schools
 - Estimated cost \$1,666,489. to set up
 - Estimated \$365,182. annual maintenance fee
