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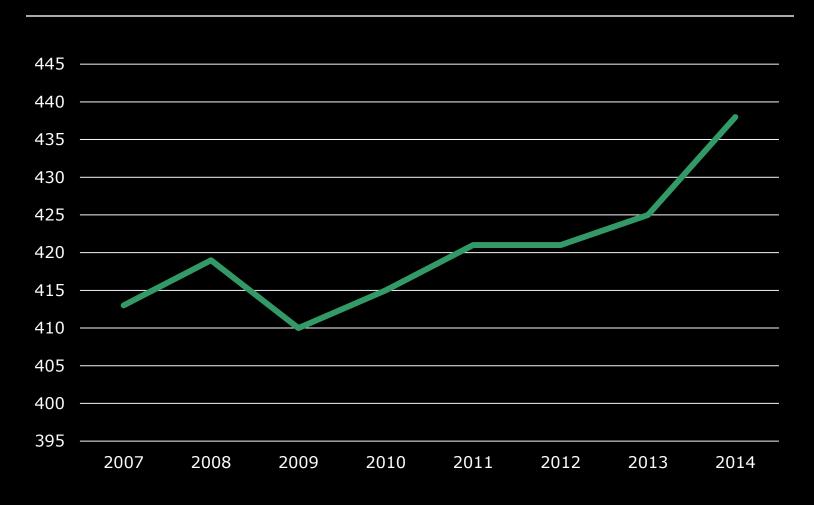

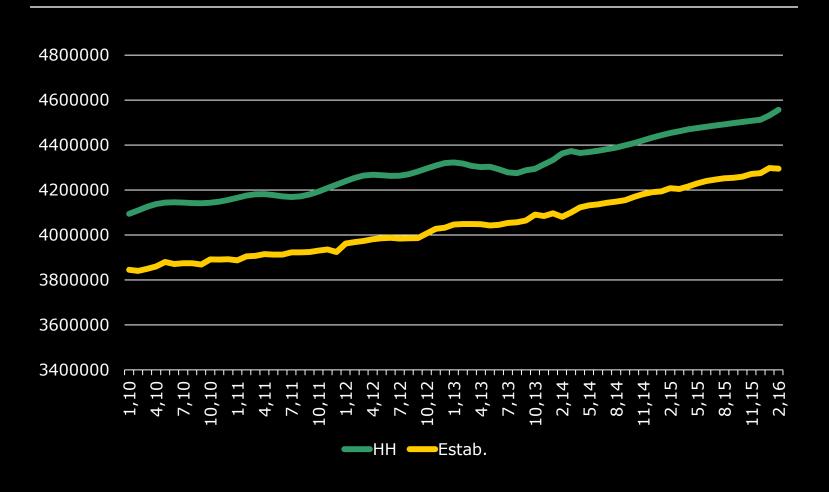

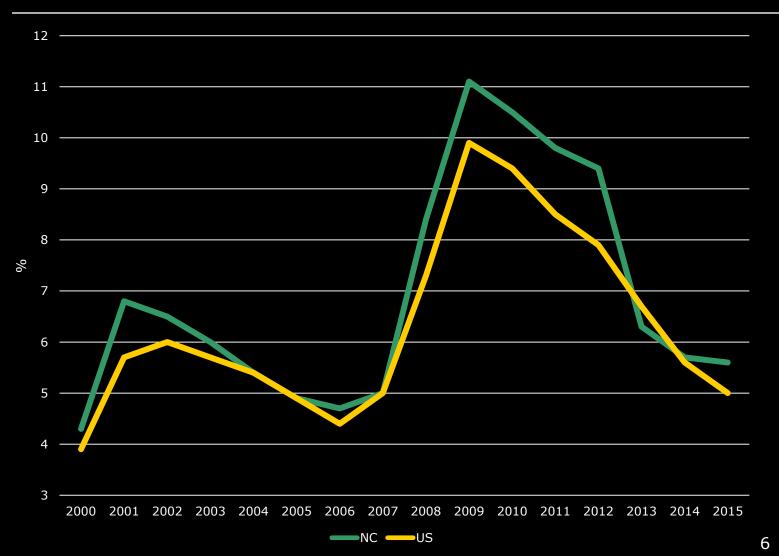

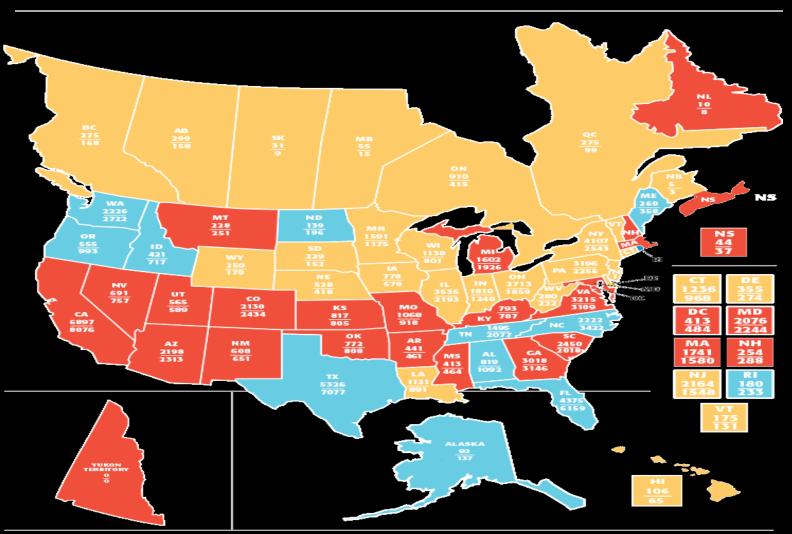
## TRENDS IN NATIONAL AND NORTH CAROLINA "HEADLINE" UNEMPLOYMENT RATE

(December of each year)

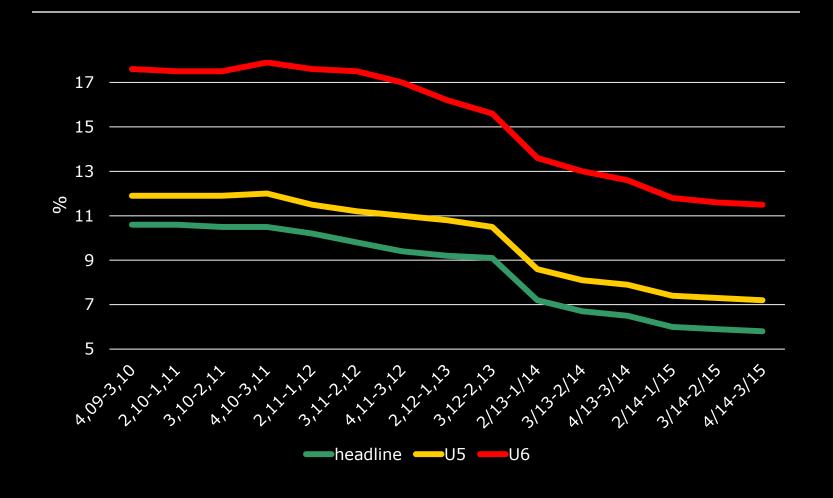

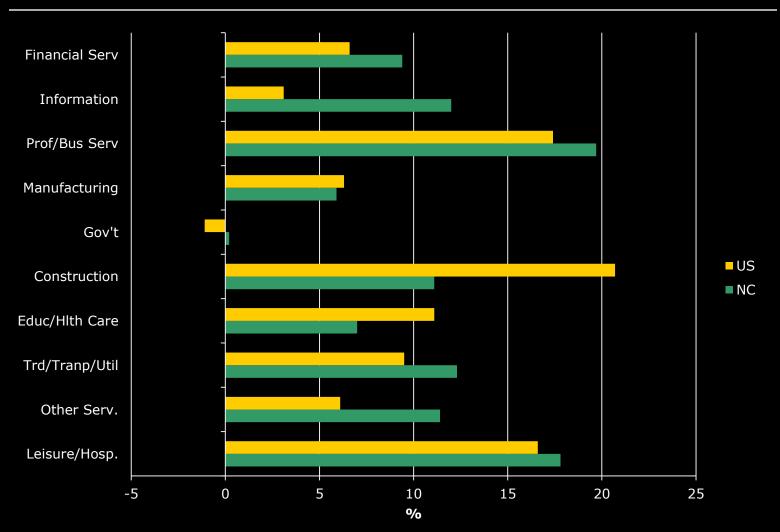
