
Juvenile Case Statutory Timeline



^{*} Hearings may be continued for "good cause" to receive additional evidence, reports, or assessments requested by the court, or other information in the child's best interest and to allow reasonable time for expeditious discovery. Otherwise, continuances only granted in "extraordinary circumstances" when necessary for the proper administration of justice or in the best interest of the juvenile.

Note: By statute, order must be entered within 30 days (or subsequent hearing to determine why order not entered; then order entered within 10 days of the subsequent hearing).
