March 20, 2014 Public Hearing Guidelines: Common Core State Standards

- 1. The two hour public hearing scheduled for March 20, 2014, from 10:00 am to 12:00 pm in Room 643 of the Legislative Office Building is conducted to accept comment and opinion on implementation of the Common Core State Standards in North Carolina public schools.
- 2. Registration for speaking at the public hearing may be made as follows:
 - a. **On-line:** On-line sign-ups will occur prior to the public hearing, opening at noon, March 13, 2014, on the General Assembly website. Online sign-ups will be limited to 30 speakers, and will close 48 hours in advance of the hearing. The link to the on-line sign-up can be found here: http://www.ncleg.net/Applications/RTS/CCCSS.aspx
 - b. **At the hearing site:** Sign-ups at the hearing site, Room 643 of the Legislative Office Building, will begin 1 hour prior to the convening of the hearing, and will close 5 minutes prior to the beginning of the hearing.
- 3. On-line registrants will need to check-in at the hearing site prior to the start of the hearing. Slots for on-line registrants who do not check-in prior to the start of the hearing will be released to on-site registrants.
- 4. Speakers will have up to 2 minutes for presentation to the Committee.
- 5. Speakers will be called according to the order of registration. The presiding chair reserves the right to re-order the speakers, in order to provide the committee with a full spectrum of opinion and ideas.
- 6. Speakers who have registered may elect to allow another individual to speak in their place at check-in if both parties are physically present at the hearing site. Substitutions and yielding of time to other parties will not be permitted after the start of the hearing.
- 7. The presiding chair, at the chair's discretion, may change these guidelines.
