

 - + Mixed results with certain success in 2 regions



 - + Not mandate by Federal or State Gov't
- GAP Cost Share Program
 - + Funds from SCBG since 2008 through current year Reimburse first time growers \$600.00 and \$300.00 thereafter.

The service certifies conformity or nonconformity to United States and other grades or contract specifications. The service is provided by the North Carolina Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services in cooperation with the United States Department of Agriculture. The service is available upon request to aid growers, shippers, brokers, receivers, processors, insurance adjusters or other financially interested parties in the packing and marketing of their product. Fees from the applicant make the service self-supporting.

Water Analysis Program

The North Carolina Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services has developed the Water Analysis Cost Share program. The purpose of this program is to encourage water testing as part of a pre- and post-harvest food safety program for fruit and vegetable crops. The program will assist in paying for the cost of testing irrigation and/or packing house wash water.




Emergency Programs

- + Their mission is to reduce the vulnerability to or the impact from, any disaster, disease or terrorist attack on the agriculture community of North Carolina. They work closely with local communities to support agrisecurity, agricultural emergency preparedness and recovery, and rapid response technology efforts.
- Essential planning for extreme food deficiency in NC and the role NCDA&CS in conjunction with Emergency Management would need to play to resolve.

- * The Small and Minority Farm Program provides services to small, limited-resource and minority farmers who are traditionally underserved.
 - + Working with several non-traditional handlers to provide foods to low-income communities.
 - Working with community leaders to provide local foods in under-served areas.


