Children are placed in a licensed Angel Care foster home for up to 90 days while the family attempts to resolve the issue that keeps them from safely caring for their children. Parents are provided mentoring and links to community resources by program managers and foster parents.; and

SECTION 7.49.(a) Of the funds appropriated to the Department of Public Instruction by this act for the 2019-2021 fiscal biennium for the North Carolina Hospitality Education Foundation (Education Foundation), the Department shall provide a grant-in-aid to the Education Foundation of the North Carolina Restaurant and Lodging Association to be used to provide nationally certified programs in career and technical education focused on developing critical skills necessary for students to succeed in the hospitality sector. The purpose of the funds shall be to support instructor and student training and student testing to increase the State's skilled workforce in the restaurant and lodging sectors. SECTION 7.49.(b) The Education Foundation, in consultation with the Department of Public Instruction, shall submit a report by April 1 of each year in which the Education Foundation spends State funds made available pursuant to this act to the Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee and the Fiscal Research Division on the activities described by this act and the use of those funds."; and
