Committee Rules

April 29, 2020

- 1. Amendments may not spend net General Fund appropriations.
- 2. Amendments may not increase the overall amount of funds transferred to or from Coronavirus Relief Reserve.
- 3. A new spending item must identify a corresponding reduction in an existing item funded from the Coronavirus Relief Fund (Fund). Amendments cannot increase the overall appropriation to the Fund.
- 4. All proposed amendments that spend funds must:
 - a. Be for expenditures allowable under the CARES Act and the formal guidance issued by the US Department of Treasury outlining permissible uses of the federal Coronavirus Relief Fund payment; and
 - b. Be for nonrecurring purposes only.
- 5. Allowable uses of the federal Coronavirus Relief Fund established in the CARES Act include:
 - Necessary expenditures incurred due to public health emergency;
 - Costs not accounted for in the most recent State budget;
 - Costs incurred during the period that begins on March 1, 2020 and ends on December 30, 2020.
- 6. Members requesting amendments agree to waive confidentiality so they can be shared with the Cochairs and staff.
- 7. A signature will not be required on amendments, instead the requesting email to staff will be considered verification.
