Severance Expenditure Reserve Update (November 1, 2011)

Section 29.21 of Session Law 2011-145 requires the Director of the Budget to allocate funds appropriated for employees who are separated from service due to a reduction-in-force action. These allocations will include a State employee's severance salary continuation, employer-related contributions for social security and noncontributory health premiums for up to 12 months. Funds appropriated to the Severance Expenditure Reserve may be allocated to public agencies for positions that are funded by the General Fund or Highway Fund.

Preliminary allocations from the Severance Expenditure Reserve are shown in the table below.
