

The Problem

North Carolina, like all states, is facing a critical teacher shortage:

- Nationwide: Education School enrollments are **down from 9.9%** of all college students in 2005 to 4.2% in 2015.
- In North Carolina, Ed School enrollments are **down 27%** over the last 4 years.
- Teacher vacancies before the start of school last year:
 - Winston Salem had 81 vacancies 47 in elementary
 - Charlotte Mecklenburg 200 vacancies with half in elementary
- The census bureau calculates the North Carolina's student population will grow by 812,000 new students by 2030.
- Baby boomers are retiring at an average of 10,000 per day.
- The Bureau of Labor Statistics says the average person changes jobs 10 times before they are 40.

Summary – teachers are retiring and leaving the profession, your student population is growing, and your colleges of education are producing less.

It is a perfect storm.



The Solution

North Carolina must have an efficient route for career changers to enter the classroom:

- Well over one third of all U.S. teachers come through alternative routes 22% in North Carolina.
- Alternative routes fill hard to staff positions such as STEM and bilingual teachers.
- Alternative certification attracts a more diverse population into teaching.
- Career changers cannot stop working to attend a college of education.
- A Harvard study found alt cert teachers performed as well as or better than teachers coming through traditional routes in raising student achievement.

Quality Alternative Certification programs provide the pre-service training these professionals need to be effective teachers in addition to ongoing support throughout the first year to ensure they are successful.

North Carolina needs alternative certification so that every student has a great teacher that is well-prepared and knows their subject matter.

North Carolina Teachers

When we come to North Carolina, we will create a customized program to meet the needs of North Carolina students.

- The program will be called North Carolina Teachers with offices in-state. We will have local staff in our offices to provide support throughout the process to all program candidates.

- There is NO COST to the state or district, and the teacher candidates only pay a small initial fee to start the program. The majority of their program fees are due ONLY after they secure a teaching position, paid in manageable monthly installments.
