SECTION #.(a) G.S. 115C-299.5 reads as rewritten:

"\§ 115C-299.5. Duty to monitor the state of the teaching profession.

- Definitions. As used in this section, the following definitions apply:
 - Hard-to-staff school. Any school identified as low-performing, as provided in G.S. 115C-105.37.
 - Hard-to-staff subject area. A subject area that is either of the following: (2)
 - As defined by the United States Department of Education.
 - A subject area that has resulted in a long-term vacancy of 16 months or more at a particular school in a local school administrative unit.
 - Teacher vacancy. A teaching position that a local board of education is (3) unable to fill with a teacher licensed in that subject area, including a position that meets any of the following criteria:
 - Is not filled with a teacher who has one of the following licenses in the subject area of the position:
 - Continuing Professional License. 1.
 - Initial Professional License. <u>2.</u>
 - Lifetime License.
 - Limited License.
 - Residency License.
 - Is not filled by a licensed teacher in a permanent assignment. b.
 - Is filled by a substitute teacher or interim teacher.
 - Is filled by a teacher with (i) an emergency license or (ii) another permit or license not included in sub-subdivision a. of this subdivision.
- State of the Teaching Profession Report. The State Board of Education shall monitor and compile an annual report by December 15 annually on the state of the teaching profession in North Carolina that includes data on the decisions of teachers to leave the teaching profession and vacancies in teaching positions as provided in subsections (c) and (e) of this section. The State Board shall adopt standard procedures for each local board of education to use in requesting
