## PUBLIC HEARING GUIDELINES

## House Election Laws Committee of the 2013 General Assembly Public Hearing on Voter ID

- 1. The public hearing is conducted to accept comment and opinion on all of the following related to voter ID:
  - a. Whether the requirement of a photo ID upon voting is good policy
  - b. If required, the impact of the requirement of a photo ID on elections, and other governmental services
  - c. If required, suggestions and ideas of how to implement a requirement for photo ID, including how to assist voters in obtaining a photo ID
- 2. Speakers need to sign up on the "Speaker Sheet" in order to speak.
- 3. Speakers will have up to 3 minutes for presentation to the Committee.
- 4. Registration for speaking will:
  - a. At the hearing site: 1 hour prior to the convening of the hearing, and will close prior to the beginning of the hearing.
  - b. **On-line:** In advance of the hearing, up to 50 speakers, and will close at 5:00 p.m. March 11, 2013, in advance of the hearing.
- 5. Speakers will be called according to the order of registration. The presiding chair reserves the right to reorder the speakers, in order to provide the committee with a full spectrum of opinion and ideas.
- 6. If a speaker is not present when called, the speaker will be skipped at that time. Time permitting at the end of all registered speakers, those skipped will be allowed to speak.
- 7. The presiding chair, at the chair's discretion, may change these guidelines.
