May 8-9, 2013 – Raleigh, NC

North Carolina Federal Advanced Technologies Symposium

This statewide Symposium, co-hosted by the NCMBC, Senator Richard Burr, the NC Military Foundation, the Institute for Defense and Business and the University of North Carolina General Administration, will focus on developing dialogue between: military commands in North Carolina with tactical and installation future technology needs; businesses and R&D entities in NC developing technologies with defense applications; and prime contractors seeking small business team members capable of meeting their technology needs. The symposium will include at least eight joint panels (military, business and university technology developers in eight technology sectors), keynote speakers from the Department of Defense and an expo of businesses with recently-developed or emerging technologies and/or technology applications.



July 10-11, 2013 –Pinehurst, NC

4th Annual North Carolina Federal Energy and Environmental Symposium

This statewide Symposium, co-hosted by the NCMBC and member(s) of the North Carolina Congressional delegation, will focus on helping installations and federal agencies meet their Net Zero goals and mandates outlined in the Department of Defense (DoD) Strategic Sustainability Performance Plan, while simultaneously creating business opportunities for North Carolina businesses. The Symposium will include a series of three Roundtables (focused on Net Zero Water, Waste and Energy), installation breakout sessions, prime contractor partnering sessions and an expo of businesses in the energy and environmental marketplace.



August 6, 2013 – Fayetteville, NC

12th Annual North Carolina Defense and Economic Development Trade Show

This Defense Trade Show, co-hosted by Senator Richard Burr, Senator Kay Hagan, the NCMBC and Fayetteville Technical Community College, connects NC businesses with major defense contractors, training and business development resources and government agencies that buy in the federal marketplace. The Defense Trade Show includes a traditional trade show of major defense contractors, a series of 10 procurement workshops, 16 "doing business with" briefings by federal agencies, structured subcontractor networking opportunities with prime contractors and an R&D Roundtable facilitated by the University of North Carolina General Administration.

2013 North Carolina Aerospace Supplier Conference

The Aerospace Suppliers Conference, co-hosted by Senator Richard Burr, the NCMBC, the North Carolina Aerospace Alliance and the North Carolina Department of Commerce, connects aerospace supplies and subcontractors in the state with major aircraft manufacturers and first tier subcontractors. The conference features: briefings by major aerospace companies about their current requirements, vendor qualification processes and future opportunities; general sessions on workforce training, quality management systems and industry trends in military, commercial and general aviation; and a trade show of North Carolina aerospace-related companies.

2013 North Carolina Federal Construction Summit

The "FEDCON Summit" brings together over 800 representatives of the Corps of Engineers, Naval Facilities Engineering Command, United States Coast Guard, Department of Veterans Affairs, GSA Public Buildings Service, other federal agencies and installations, general and specialty contractors, designers and construction suppliers in North Carolina. The Summit program will focus on traditional military construction, sustainment, restoration and modernization (SRM) construction and energy and other environmental construction and engineering opportunities at bases in North Carolina. The summit will include a business expo, general and breakout sessions focused on project forecasts and contracting processes, and speed networking with major primes and federal agency and military installation representatives.
