

AP Student Enrollment in At Least One AP Course

Statewide and Target District

Initial Success:

- The number of AP Exam-Takers in North Carolina's public schools increased 18.7% from 2014 to 2015, as compared to a 6% increase in AP Exam-Takers in public schools nationwide.
- The number of Black AP Exam-Takers in North Carolina's public schools increased 22.8% from 2014 to 2015, as compared to a 3.6% increase in Black AP Exam-Takers in public schools nationwide.
- The number of Hispanic AP Exam-Takers in North Carolina's public schools increased 21.3% from 2014 to 2015, as compared to an 8.2% increase in Hispanic AP Exam-Takers in public schools nationwide.
