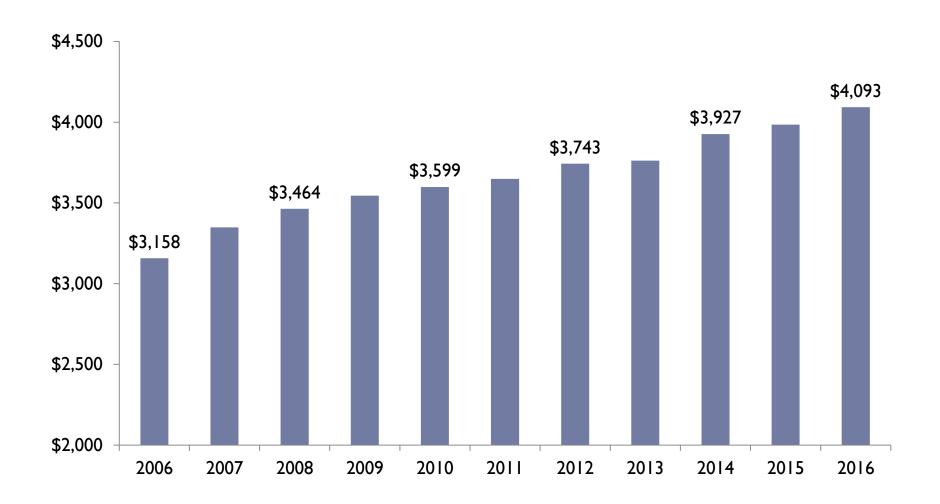
Allotment Formula for Children with Disabilities (PRC 032)

Funding for Children with Disabilities (age 5-21) is computed using two components:

- 1. Number of Eligible Children with Disabilities
 - Eligibility defined by State Board of Education
 - April I count of students used for upcoming fiscal year
 - Select the <u>lesser</u> of the April 1 count or an overall 12.5 percent cap on Allotted ADM
- 2. Funding Factor- Dollars per eligible funded headcount
 - Set through appropriations process
 - \$4,093 \$ per student in FY 2016-17

Multiply (1) and (2) for a final LEA allotment amount

History of the Funding Cap

1978-79:

• General Assembly directed the State Board of Education (SBE) to develop and implement a new funding formula for special education

1980-81:

- Advisory Budget Commission of the General Assembly approved a revised funding formula from the SBE, funded Children with Disabilities up to 12.5% of LEAs ADM
- Included internal caps based on national rates for each type of disability (removed in 1987-88)

1993-96:

Additional funds given to LEAs over 12.5% cap

Potential Effects of Funding Cap

- Unmet need for districts over cap
- Financial incentive for overidentification

- National and Statewide percentages vary:
 - Students served under federal IDEA funds: 13%
 - ▶ 2016 North Carolina Statewide Average: 12.27%
 - ▶ CDC: 15.4%

Limitations and Notes on Estimates

- Cost Estimates use:
 - Revised April 2016 headcounts of Children with Disabilities
 - Revised 2016-17 Allotted ADM
 - \$/Student amount of \$4,093
- Assumes no change in total identified students with disabilities with a change in allotment cap
- Does not include Charter Schools
