

### **2016 Disaster Recovery Act FMAG Funds**

**Fire Management Assistance Grant Program (FMAG)** is available for the mitigation, management, and control of fires on publicly or privately owned forests, which threaten such destruction as would constitute a major disaster. The grant provides a 75% Federal cost share with the State paying the remaining 25% of actual allowable costs.

# 2016 Disaster Recovery Act Claridge Nursery Operation and Repair Goldsboro, NC

Hurricane Matthew destroyed the Nursery's seedling crop and damaged fields and buildings.

Fourteen structures on site require repair. The estimated cost to repair the buildings is \$467,919. FEMA funding will be requested to cover 75% of the repair work.

\$1,500,000 was allocated to the Nursery in the Disaster Recovery Act to cover operational and repair expenses. The Nursery used its cash reserves to cover expenses until June 2017 when \$122,999.92 in disaster funds were used to cover operational expenses. The remaining \$1,377,001 will be used to cover the State's 25% share of the repair costs and any other operational needs.
