



## Disaster Recovery Appropriation

Commerce appropriated \$10 million through the Disaster Recovery Act of 2016 to provide grants to local governments to repair or replace existing infrastructure or construct infrastructure to support new residential structures in areas outside the 100-year floodplain.

For this program, infrastructure includes nonresidential buildings that serve the public, water, sewer, sidewalks, storm drainage, and other similar projects.

#### Outreach & Timeline

- February 2017—Grant availability announced publicly and application materials posted on website
- February 2017—Commerce partnered with the Association of County Commissioners, League of Municipalities, and Golden LEAF Foundation to hold information sessions in Lumberton, Kenansville, New Bern, Raleigh, Elizabeth City and Williamston.
- April 2017—First round of funding awards announced
- June 2017—Second round of funding awards announced

# Grant Awards Summary

- 15 grants in 9 counties
- \$6,449,311 awarded
- Projects include 6 storm drainage, 4 sewer, 2 water, 2 road/paving and 1 public building
- \$2.6 million committed to Edgecombe County (Princeville)
- \$950,000 in reserve for cost overruns and contingencies
