



Preparing a social or developmental history on a child with a disability.






Services to Students

- Providing Crisis Intervention
- Developing intervention strategies

 Helping the child develop social interaction skills

And

 Assist with conflict resolution & anger management



Services to Parents/Families

- Interviewing to assess problems
- Working with parents to facilitate their support in child school adjustment
- Assist to alleviate family stress
- Assist parent to access programs
- Assist parent in accessing and utilizing school and community resources

Services to School Personnel

- Providing staff with essential information
- Assessing mental health concerns
- Developing staff in-service training programs
- Assisting teachers with behavior management
- Direct Support

School-Community Liaison

- Obtaining and coordinating community resources to meet students' needs
- Helping school districts receive adequate support from social and mental health agencies
- Advocating
- Helping the system respond to meet each child's need

Services to Districts


- Assist in developing and implementing educational programs


