

Recycling Solar Panels in North Carolina

The Division of Environmental Assistance and Customer Service (DEACS) in the North Carolina Department of Environmental Quality operates a Recycling Markets Directory that can be utilized to identify recycling companies that can accept solar panels for recycling. To use the directory, follow these steps:
