9 **CONSIDERATION OF RISKS TO PUBLIC HEALTH**

10 SECTION 16.3.(a) G.S. 130A-303 reads as rewritten:

11 **"§ 130A-303. Imminent hazard.**

12 (a) The judgment of the Secretary that an imminent hazard exists concerning solid waste
13 shall be supported by findings of fact made by the Secretary.

14 (b) In order to eliminate an imminent hazard, the Secretary may, without notice or
15 hearing, issue an order requiring that immediate action be taken to protect the public health or
16 the environment. This order may be directed to a generator or transporter of solid waste or to the
17 owner or operator of a solid waste management facility. Where the imminent hazard is caused
18 by an inactive hazardous substance or waste disposal site, the Secretary shall follow the
19 procedures set forth in G.S. 130A-310.5.

20 (c) When a state of emergency, as defined in G.S. 166A-19.3, has been declared by the
21 Governor due to a natural disaster such as a pandemic, epidemic, hurricane or flood, or due to a
22 pending disaster, the Secretary, or an authorized representative of the Secretary, may develop
23 and implement any emergency measures and procedures that the Secretary deems necessary to
24 protect the public health or the environment for the proper management of solid waste generated
25 during the declared emergency.

26 (d) Written notice of emergency measures and procedures developed and implemented
27 pursuant to this section shall be provided to news media, waste organizations, governmental
28 agencies, solid waste facilities, and any other interested or affected parties as determined by the
29 Secretary. Such emergency procedures and measures may include any of the following:

30 (1) Restrictions on the collection, storage, and transportation of solid waste.

31 (2) Decisions on facility operational conditions such as operational times and
32 waste acceptance.

2 (k) A county or city may petition the Department for a waiver from the prohibition on
3 disposal of a material described in subdivisions (3), (9), (10), (11), (12), and (13) of subsection
4 (f) of this section and subsection (f3) of this section in a landfill based on a showing that
5 prohibiting the disposal of the material would constitute an economic ~~hardship~~ hardship or a real
6 or potential public health risk.

2 **"AUTHORIZE MODIFICATION OF CRIMINAL JUDGEMENTS REQUIRING**
3 **INTERMITTENT ACTIVE TIME**

4 **SECTION 30.5.(a)** Any criminal judgment requiring a defendant to serve periods of
5 confinement or imprisonment in a local confinement facility may be modified by the chief district
6 court judge of the judicial district in which the order was issued if the chief district court judge
7 finds that all of the following requirements are met:

8 (1) The defendant is unable to serve one or more ordered periods of confinement
9 or imprisonment due to the local confinement facility's restrictions on inmates
10 during the COVID-19 State of Emergency.

11 (2) Without modification, the defendant will be in violation of the criminal
12 judgment.

13 (3) The District Attorney consents to modification of the criminal judgment.

14 Any modification made pursuant to this authorization shall be as minimal as possible to allow
15 the defendant to comply with the requirements of the criminal judgment.

16 **SECTION 30.5.(b)** This section is effective when it becomes law and expires 90
17 days after the termination of the COVID-19 State of Emergency."
