8	(c) Procedure for Fund Disbursements. – With respect to funds used pursuant to		
9	subdivision (b)(1)subdivisions (b)(1) and (b)(1a) of this section, the State Treasurer shall disburse		
0	the principal of the Fund only upon the written direction of the Director of the Division. With		
1	respect to funds used pursuant to subdivision (b)(2) of this section, the State Treasurer shall		
2	disburse the principal of the Fund only upon the written direction of both the Marine Fisheries		
3	Commission and the Funding Committee established by subsection (d) of this section following		
4	the procedures set forth in the memorandum of understanding developed under subsection (f) of		
5	this section. In the event of a disagreement between the Commission and the Committee, the		
6	Secretary of Environmental Quality shall decide between the directions proposed by the		
7	Commission and by the Committee.
