REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL STATE RESPONSE:

To protect the public health of students, employees and their families

In recognition of NCICU campuses' educational value to the State:

90k Students

1 in 4 Bachelor's degrees; 1 in 3 graduate and professional degrees \$14.2B Economic impact 66k Employees

NCICU requests support to independent colleges and universities to be distributed based on a formula determined by 75% of number of NCNBS recipients and 25% of non-NCNBS recipients

COLLEGES & UNIVERSITIES

REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL STATE RESPONSE: Financial Aid - \$20M

- Additional State aid is needed for the fall; many campuses have waiting lists of students who need additional support
- All of the current NC COVID-19 relief funds must be expended by December 30, while the need for additional financial aid will continue into the spring and into next year.



REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL STATE RESPONSE: PPE/Cleaning/Sanitizing - \$15M

Purchase and Replenishing of PPE/Cleaning/Sanitizing

- Masks, face shields, gowns, gloves
- Hand sanitizer, dispensers, signage
- Protective plexiglass shields and barriers
- CDC approved disinfectants
- Increased HVAC filtration, increased HVAC cleaning
- Additional costs associated with increased cleaning



REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL STATE RESPONSE: Testing for COVID-19 - \$12M

Testing of students, faculty and staff in compliance with CDC and DHHS guidance



REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL STATE RESPONSE: Institutional Support - \$4M

- Increased cost of technology licensing and technology for students
- Costs associated with isolation and quarantine
- Costs for reconfiguration of campus facilities to meet
 CDC and DHHS guidance



REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL STATE RESPONSE \$51M

Financial Aid: \$20 million

PPE/Cleaning/Sanitizing: \$15 million

Testing for COVID-19: \$12 million

Institutional Support: \$ 4 million

\$51 million

Given the diverse needs of institutions, NCICU would request flexibility in using the state support for the purposes listed above.
