



#### Degrees Awarded 2010–2011

- ➤ 30% of bachelor's degrees
- ➤ 45% of medical degrees
- ➤ 60% of law degrees
- > 54% of pharmacy degrees
- > 25% of teachers from North Carolina colleges

**SAVINGS** 

Legislative Tuition Grant \$1,850 per student

State Contractual Scholarship Fund \$1,350 per student - grants vary based on need

**SAVINGS** 

50% LTG recipients eligible for Pell Grants

80% LTG recipients eligible for need-based aid

#### **SAVINGS**

#### Governor's Budget:

- ➤ Cuts LTG funding by \$6.5 million
- ➤ Does not include enrollment increases for LTG/SCSF of \$5 million, which is another 5% cut to students
- ➤Total cut to LTG/SCSF is almost 12% or over \$220 per student.
