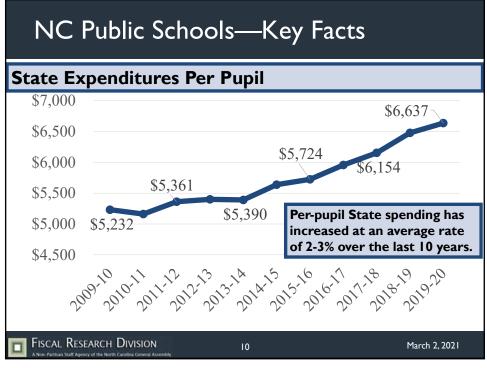
LEAs vary greatly

 - Poverty

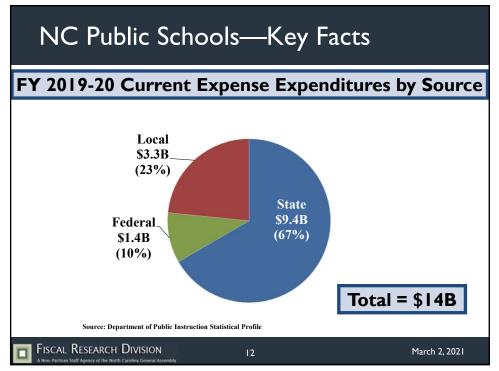

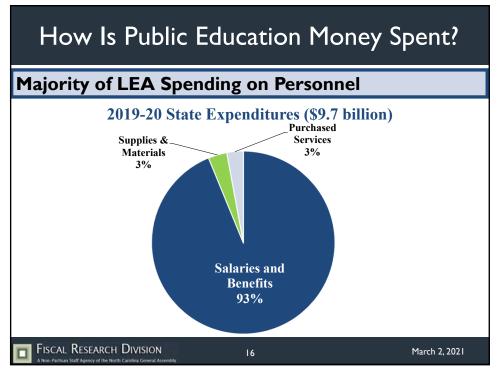
FY 2021-23 Base Budget
