May 10, 2001, Thursday at 7 p.m. – Fayetteville

Main Site:

Cumberland County Health Department (Fayetteville), Room 411.

From Raleigh: From Raleigh, take 401 North. US 401 becomes Ramsey Street new Fayetteville. Stay on US 401 (Ramsey Street) until you get to Rowan Street and stay on Rowan Street until you get to Bragg Blvd. Turn left onto Bragg Blvd. And cross Hay Street onto Robeson Street just as you pass Highsmith Rainey Memorial Hospital. Turn right onto Russell Street. You will then see E. Newton Smith Public Health Center; a tan, four-story rock type building behind the hospital.

Auxiliary Sites:

Coastal Carolina Community College (Jacksonville), Learning Resources, Library, Rm. 201.

From Raleigh: Follow I-40 East to Kenansville Exit 373; follow NC 111 to US 24 East; follow US 24 to Jacksonville; travel North on US 17; turn right on Western Boulevard. Coastal is on the left. Turn at middle entrance where there is a semicircle. Don't turn at the entrance where there is a Checkers restaurant. Pull into the semicircle and park. Take the sidewalk up to the 2nd building, which is the library and where Learning Resources is located.

UNC-Pembroke (Pembroke), Business Administration Building, Rm. 125.

From Raleigh: Take I-95 South to Exit 17. Turn right onto Highway 711. Go straight through the light and travel about 10 miles to Pembroke. Follow 711 through Pembroke until you reach the fourth light. UNCP is across the street on the right. You are now on a road called Faculty Lane. This is the main entrance into campus. Go over the railroad track and you will pass the library on the left two dorms on the right and next to the dorms is the education building and we are the building beside the education building. The name of the building where the conference is held is the Business Administration Building.

May 11, 2001, Friday at 7 p.m. – Wilmington**Main Site:**

Cape Fear College (Wilmington), 411 N. Front St., S Building, Rm.S-501.

From Raleigh: Take I-40 and follow it to Wilmington. I-40 becomes NC 132. Take the US-17/US-74 exit towards Wilmington/Wrightsville Beach. Turn left onto US 17-S (Market St.). Go straight about 1 mile and turn right onto Third St. Drive four blocks and turn left onto Walnut St. Visitors may park in the lot on the right at the corner of Second and Walnut streets. Walk toward river one block. The S building is the section of building on the corner of Front and Walnut St.

Auxiliary Sites:

Topsail High School (Hampstead), Rm. 14.

From Raleigh: Take I-40 East. Take the Hampstead/Topsail Beach exit to 210. Follow 210 until you get to Hampstead which is at Hwy.17. Make a left onto Hwy.17. The high school is 3 miles ahead on left.

Pender High School Cyber Campus (Burgaw), Cyber Campus Room.

From Raleigh: Take Highway 40 East to Burgaw exit. That will be Highway 53. Follow Highway 53 for 5 miles out of town. The High school is 5 miles west of Burgaw on Highway 53.

Brunswick Comm. College (Supply), Building A, second floor, Rm.212.

The campus is located off US 17, midway between the South Carolina line and Wilmington. The entrance is located near mile marker 25.

From Raleigh: Take 40 East to Wilmington, then take US 17 South through Wilmington, Go over the Cape Fear River bridge and the campus is about 30 minutes farther on the left. You'll see blue and white signs for the campus. Drive around to front of campus to the building with an arch on it – that is Building A, the Administration building. Parking will be available in Parking Lot A, which is directly in front of the building.

May 12, 2001, Saturday at 9:30 a.m. – Greenville**Main Site:**

Pitt Community College (Greenville), Fulford Building, Rm. 153.

Take I-440 East. Take the US-64 East/US-264 East exit, exit number 13B towards Rocky Mount/Wilson. This becomes US-64 East. Take the US-264 exit towards Wilson (NC-97)/Greenville. Continue on 264 E through Wilson into Greenville. You will pass the hospital on the left when you get into Greenville. Continue until you come to the intersection where McDonalds is on the left, take a right onto Memorial Drive. Travel South on Memorial. When you pass Carolina East Mall on your right you are less than a mile from our campus. Continue pass the mall until you see Pitt Community College's campus on the right. Turn right after you pass the campus (you will see a Trademart on the left and Sam's on the right). Take your first right and the Fulford building is the first building on the left.

Auxiliary Sites:

Eastern NC School for the Deaf (Wilson), Vestal Hall.

ENCSD is located on Highway 301 N. (The street address is 1311 Highway 301 N.). There is a sign at the entrance....visible from Highway 301 N. The Highway Room is in Vestal Hall. When you drive into the campus...if you drive straight in, you will run into the Vestal Hall Building. Parking is right in front of the building--between Woodard Hall, the Administrative Building and Vestal Hall. The largest building you will see is Massey Center on the right as you face Vestal Hall.

Beaufort Comm. College (Washington), CIH Teleclassroom - Building 9, Rm. 937.

From Raleigh - Travel Hwy 64 East through Rocky Mount until the 4-lane ends in Williamston at Hwy 17. Make a right on Hwy. 17 headed south. Stay on 17 south, when you reach Washington make a left at the first stop light on 15th St. Follow it until it intersects Hwy. 264 East. Make a left onto 264 East at Eastern Elem. School. The college is 5 miles down 264 East on the left. Building 9 is located behind the main, 2-story building in the center of campus. The NCIH room is 9-937. No restrictions on parking.

From Wilson - Travel Hwy. 264 East around Greenville and continue on 264 East to Washington. Hwy. 264 goes straight through town. Keep following 264 East from Washington. The college is located 5 miles east of Washington on Hwy. 264 on the left side of road. Building 9 is located behind the main, 2-story building in the center of campus. The NCIH room is 9-937. No restrictions on parking.

May 12, 2001, Saturday at 4:00 p.m. – Edenton

Main Site:

Holmes High School (Edenton), Room #145 in Media Center.

From Raleigh, Take Hwy 64 East. Stay on 64 until it ends in Williamston. Upon exiting 64 @ Williamston, turn left - taking 64 E, 17 N (At Williamston, Hwy 64 will join Hwy 17).

Hwy 17 & 64 will split in Williamston. STAY on Hwy 17 N. After crossing the Chowan River Bridge, take the 3rd Exit for Edenton. At the end of the off ramp, turn left. At the 4th light turn right. Once you turn right, you will be on Broad Street. Take the 3rd Road to your left. (The High School will have just been on your left.) At the stop sign, turn left.

You will be in front of John A. Holmes High School. If parking is not available in front of the school, you may park in the unpaved parking lot in front of our baseball field. Was on your left when you turned off of Broad Street. The hearing is in Room # 145 in Media Center. It is a single story building, to the left of our main building, connected by a breezeway. Signs directing you to our NCIH Room will be posted.

Auxiliary Sites:

College of the Albemarle (Elizabeth City), Building E, Rm. 111.

From Raleigh: Take 64 to Williamston. Pick up Hwy. 17 N and follow it into Elizabeth City. The campus is on the right side past the hospital. Take the second entrance into campus and you will see a parking lot which is directly in front of Building E.

College of the Albemarle (Manteo), Technology building, ground floor auditorium.

From Raleigh: Take 64/264 to Manteo. Keep going thru Manteo till you get almost to other end of island. You will come to Russell Twiford Rd., take a left, and the campus is one half block up on left. The Technology building is the 2nd larger building on the left. The auditorium is on the ground floor when you walk in.

Halifax Comm. College (Weldon), 100-200 Building in Rm.143.

From Raleigh (Traveling on Highway 64 East): Take Highway 64 East to Interstate 95. Exit onto I-95 North. Travel I-95 North to Weldon/Roanoke Rapids (Exit 173). When you come off the ramp at Weldon/Roanoke Rapids go right at the stoplight. Halifax Community College will be on your right on Highway 158 about ¼ - ½ mile from the exit ramp. It is located at the second stoplight after the exit ramp stoplight.

From I-85: Take the Oine Exit off of I-85 and follow Hwy. 158-East to Roanoke Rapids. Halifax Community College will be on your right about 1/2 mile past the Hwy.158/I-95 Interchange. (You will pass beneath I-95 prior to reaching the college.) This is approximately a 30 - 45 minute drive after exiting off I-85, depending on whether or not you get behind slow moving traffic such as farm equipment, etc.
