# Curriculum Support (34%)

- Virtual Instruction
- International Staffing
- Learning Loss
  - Tutoring
  - Learning Platforms

# Children with Disabilities and Health Services (21.3%)

- Speech & Language Services
- Audiology Services
- Nursing Services
- Occupational and Physical Therapy
- COVID Nurses and Testing

# Safety and Security (17.5%)

- School Resource Officers
  - At least one in every building, including elementary schools
- Security Consultants

# Miscellaneous (14.5%)

- Legal Services
- Financial Audits
- Employee Background Checks
- Transportation
  - Homeless
  - EC Students
- Technology
  - Fiber Installation
  - Equipment Repair/Replacement

# Maintenance (12.7%)

- Custodial Supplies and Services
- Maintenance Services
  - More complicated but not major replacements
    - HVAC
    - Building Inspections
    - Concrete Work
    - Carpets/Flooring

# Procedures for Contracting

- State Procurement Guidelines (\$30,000 for bidding/quotes)
- Federal Uniform Guidance (\$10,000 for bidding/quotes)
- Local Procedures (\$5,000 for bidding/quotes)



# Contract Expenditures

- Overall District Budget FY22 - \$300m
  - Contracts - Approximately 3% of Total Budget (\$10m)
    - State – 42%
    - Federal – 13%
    - Local – 45%
