MEMORANDUM

TO: Members of the General Assembly
FROM: O. Walker Reagan, Director of Research *OWR*
RE: Non-Revenue and Non-Appropriations Bills Crossover List

House Rule 31.1 (e) requires that, in order to be eligible for consideration by the House in the rest of this year's Regular Session, any Senate bill or resolution must have been received from the Senate and read on the floor of the House no later than May 14, 2009. The following legislation is excepted from this House crossover deadline:

1. An adjournment resolution; or
2. A measure that:
 - a. must be referred to the appropriations or finance committees (see Rule 38);
 - b. would establish districts for Congress or State or local entities (see Rule 31.1(g)); or
 - c. would ratify an amendment or amendments to the U.S. Constitution (see Rule 31.1(g)).

Senate Rule 41 requires that, in order to be eligible for consideration by the Senate in the rest of this year's and next year's regular sessions, any House bill or resolution must have been received from the House and read on the floor of the Senate no later than May 14, 2009. The following legislation is excepted from this Senate crossover deadline:

1. An adjournment resolution; or
2. A measure that must be referred to the appropriations or finance committees (see Rule 42).

Under the Crossover Deadline Agreement of May 12, 2009, signed by the Speaker of the House and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, a bill or resolution passed by either chamber on May 14, 2009 and ordered sent to the other chamber complies with the crossover rules.

Attached is a list prepared by the legislative Information Systems Division containing those measures that no later than May 14, 2009 passed one chamber and were received by or ordered sent to the other chamber. You may view the current status of these and other bills on the General Assembly web page at www.ncleg.net.

This list does not include appropriations and revenue measures exempt from the crossover deadline, unless such a measure has passed from one chamber to the other by May 14, 2009. Individual analysis of the particular measure not "crossing over" is necessary to determine whether it is subject to the crossover deadline. This list also does not include ratified legislation as of May 14 which, if vetoed, would be constitutionally eligible for continued consideration.
